  of the objects stipulated herein is against public policy.
- 10. The Parties shall designate their respective representatives who shall be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.
- 11. The parties may negotiate amendments to this MOU, if necessary, to meet the evolving requirements. Any modification and indications to the MOU will require written approval from both parties.
- 12. The duration of this MoU is for a period of 3 years from 16th May, 2022 to 15th May, 2025. It can be extended with a mutual written agreement by both parties.
- The MoU can be terminated without assigning any reason by giving a 1-month notice to the other party under this MoU.
- 14. In case of disagreement between the Parties regarding the interpretation or application of the provisions of this Memorandum, the Parties will resolve them through negotiations and consultations.


