### DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO STATUTE GOVERNING RECOGNITIONS OF INSTITUTIONS AS RESEARCH CENTRES

(Framed under Section 40 (1) (P) read with Section 66 of the K.S.U Act 2000) PREAMBLE:

Statute governing recognition of Institutions as Research Centres in Mangalore University were assented by the Hon'ble Chancellor on 10.02.2005 as Communicated in Govt letter No ED 42 UDS 2004 dated 31.03.2005 and notified vide this office Notification No MU/ACC/CR.6/2005-06/A3 dated 20.04.2005 for implementation with immediate effect.

Now, as per the National Education Policy to encourage the Research activities and Higher education in the colleges Mangalore University has taken steps to made provision in the existing statute and the same has been approved in the bodies of the University. Hence this amendment

MANGALORE UNIVERSITY

#### 1. Title and Commencement:

- i. This Statute shall be called "The Statute Governing Recognition of Institution as Research Centre"
  - ii. The Statute Shall come in to force from the date of assent of the Chancellor
- 2. The Recognition of Institutions shall be on the basis of the conditions required for running the Ph.D programme as stipulated by the University from time to time
- On receipt of request or a proposal from the head of the following categories of on Minstitutions where necessary facilities for research and qualified staff are available to guide research students, the Syndicate may accord recognition to them as centres of research for award of Ph.D degrees by Mangalore University.
- Laboratories of All India nature or other Institutions maintained by the Government of India where research work is being carried out
- Research Institutions maintained by a state Government or a QuasiGovernment/ Research Centre established by the affiliated colleges of
  Mangalore University/ Autonomous Institution recognized by the Central
  or State Government/ Contral

### Followed by the conditions:

- a) Colleges desirous to have a Research Centre recognized by the University for offering Ph.D. programme, should first establish an independent research centre consisting of the PG Departments which are in existence for at least five years, headed by a Director, osal from the head of the following entergories of
- b) The personnel involved with the research centre drawn from different disciplines having a doctorate degree should demonstrate the ability to carry out independent research by means of publications other than those resulting





from their Ph.D. thesis work, in referred, repaired journals (excluding in-h multidisciplinary fournals) which are indexed by reputed organizations, pages 18 organizations.

- c) The research centre should have infrastructure to carry out research in emerging areas. The infrastructure should consist of well-equipped laboratories, separate library with latest reference books as well as national and international journals and e resources.
- d) In the Social Science subjects, the Research Centre should have world class corpus of Archival materials, Medieval literature, Epigraphical, Archeological material and a number of journals as well as reference books.
  - e) The college which intends to start Research Centre in any subject shall have post Graduate programme in the respective subject.
- 4. The Syndicate shall consult the Boards of Studies in the respective subjects and / or appoint a commission to inspect the institution and obtain a report before arriving at a decision in the matter of recognition of an Institution.
  - 5. The Syndicate, while recognizing the Institution, may specify the subjects or areas for which the institution is recognized
- 6. The institution seeking recognition shall pay the recognition fee etc. as prescribed by the University from time to time
- 7. When an Institution is recognized the above manner, a candidate intending to carry out research in that institution shall ordinarily work under the guidance of a member of staff of that Institution recognized by the University as a research guide.
- 8. Recognition accorded to an Institution ma subsequently be withdrawn by the Syndicate in full or in part, if the Institution fails to fulfill the conditions required for running Ph.D programme as stipulated by the University from to time

# Guidelines for Research, Publication and other allied activities at the Institute

#### Aims and Objectives of the Research Policy:

Research and Development (R and D) cell aims to create and support the research culture at the Institute through a research policy for promoting research and maintaining integrity in research among the faculties, staff, and students. It is also expected to meet the requirements of Mangalore University which assumed the responsibility of a functioning research center, offering the Ph. D, program in management. It also aims at ensuring that the research activities of the University conform to all applicable rules and regulations as well as to the established standards and norms relating to the safe and ethical conduct of research.

#### **Objectives:**

- Developing and recommending rules, procedures, and guidelines for granting research funds and supporting all other related activities.
- Developing and suggesting rules, procedures, and guidelines for granting academic leave, pre-grant of vacation, reduction-in-workload, etc. to the
- Faculty members undertaking research activities.
- Developing and suggesting rules, procedures, and guidelines for research-related fees
  from the research scholars deputed by Mangalore University to pursue research at the
  Institute and also the facilities to offer at the research centre.
- Guide the faculty members in the practical integration of research projects with the regular curriculum implementation and curriculum enrichment activities
- Identifying and informing researchers about the appropriate research opportunities announced by different academic, research, industry, or government organizations.
- Identifying and establishing linkages including MOUs for long-term relationships with industry bodies and individual companies for creating opportunities for teachers and





students of the University to involve themselves in real-life research projects and obtaining sponsorships.





- Encouraging and facilitating the publication of the research work/projects in reputed academic journals
- Encouraging and facilitating the presentation/communication of the research work/projects and their findings and recommendations through academic events such as workshops/seminars/guest lectures/ conferences.
- Compiling data on all the research work/projects undertaken by the teachers and students into a database for easy monitoring and analysis of the progress being made by them from year to year
- Adopting a research code, which informs all researchers about the ethical and legal norms and principles to be followed in the conduct of research
- Preparing and implementing research quality assurance mechanisms to ensure that all research activities of the University conform to standard quality specifications
- Preparing and implementing research quality assurance mechanisms in relation to project work of students.

K on payment of Rs. 1,100/- (Rupees One Thousand One Hundred Only) (Rs.550/- for SC/ST/CAT-I candidates on production of Caste certificate) through Challan or D D of any Nationalized Banks drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, Mangalore University.

#### ELIGIBILITY

Candidates for admission to the Ph.D programme shall have a Master's degree or a
professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding
statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade
'B' in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading
system is followed).

Foreign students, including those applying through their Govt. agencies/embassies should contact the respective department in which they intend to register for the Ph.D Programme, to get clearance from the Department Council concerned through the Director, International Student Centre of the University.

2. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation in grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/CAT-I (non-creamy layer)/ differently-abled and other categories of candidates or for those who had obtained their master's degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991 as per UGC norms. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying examination marks without including any gracing.





- 3. Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. Programme with course work, with atleast 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) are eligible to register for Ph.D Programme. A relaxation of 5% of marks; from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ CAT-I (non- creamy layer)/ differently- abled and other categories of candidates as per UGC norms.
- 4. Candidates possessing a degree considered equivalent to M. Phil. Degree with course work of an India/Foreign educational institution shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D Programme (please see clause 1)
