Description of Event: As a part of vigilance program MRPL MSNIM vigilance awareness competitions were conducted in the campus.


The various competitions were conducted in the campus of MSNIM IN association with MRPL were students from different colleges participated.

languages is encouraged. Sweets are distributed as a part of the celebration. **Objective:** To focus on national unity and development.








5. International Yoga Day:
